## Bridging Science, Practice, and Policy of Nature Restoration



**SERE2024** is an international conference organised by the European Chapter of the Society for Ecological Restoration (SERE), taking place in Europe every two years. During the last week of August 2024, everyone working on the science, practice, and policy of ecological restoration will come together in Tartu, Estonia, to share knowledge and discuss the future of European nature.

Ecological restoration is a topic that holds a prominent place on both political and scientific agendas. The decline in biodiversity demands our urgent attention, and degraded ecosystems around the world require an effective and knowledge-driven path to recovery. The EU is actively working on the Nature Restoration Law, and in 2024, new goals and specific actions will be agreed upon to reverse biodiversity decline in Europe. The development of National action plans for nature restoration are the next major step under the EU framework which requires matching scientific rigour and effective governance. Achieving the EU ambitious restoration goals is a challenge of unprecedented scale and requires major resource mobilisation (billions of euros), collaboration between public and private sectors and increased social engagement.

The SERE2024 conference in Tartu will serve as an excellent meeting point during this crucial time to devise the most effective approaches for the long-term recovery of nature. It offers an opportunity to foster the reciprocal exchange of ideas, knowledge, and experiences among researchers, practitioners and policymakers from across Europe. The sessions will cover topics ranging from the theory and practice of restoring various ecosystems (wetlands, grasslands, forests, rivers, agroecosystems, urban and marine ecosystems) to the socioeconomic and political contexts of ecological restoration.

### **ABOUT THE AUDIENCE**

As one of the major European ecological events, the conference is expected to bring together around 400 participants from all across Europe and beyond. The last SERE conference in Spain had attendees from 47 countries and four continents, with the majority of participants (80%) from Europe.

### LOCATION

SERE2024 will take place in Estonia – a Nordic–Baltic country rich in nature where a wide variety of restoration efforts have already been carried out. The conference city Tartu is the European Capital of Culture in 2024, making the destination more attractive for potential attendees.



### ESTONIA...

...has a population of just 1.3 million but is larger than Denmark or the Netherlands. Being among the least densely populated countries in Europe, Estonia makes for a great nature and city break destination for those looking to stretch out their limbs and enjoy some peace, quiet, and solitude.

... might easily be called the kingdom of bogs since approximately one quarter of the country is covered in marshes. From any point on Estonia's mainland, the nearest marsh is always less than 10 km away.

...is more than 50% forest. It's fair to say that Estonians have a certain tree-hugging spirit. More than half of the country is covered by forested land and almost a quarter is protected by nature. As a result, Estonia has the 4th best air quality in the world.

...has over 2,000 islands. Estonia is the only Baltic country with a deep-rooted and extensive island culture. Although most are uninhabited, Estonian islands tend to be rural, with some holding traces of their local Viking and medieval legacy.

...has 6 national parks, 3 of which have EUROPARC Federation recognition. Read more <u>here</u>.
